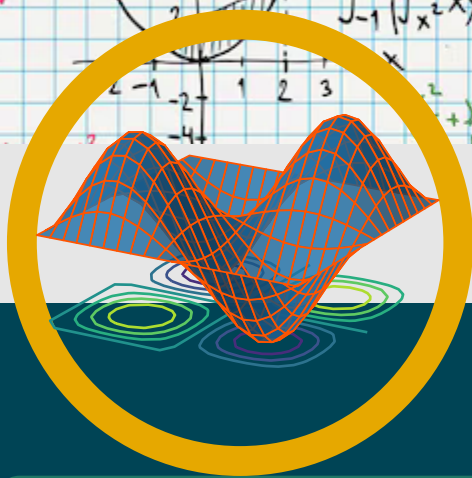
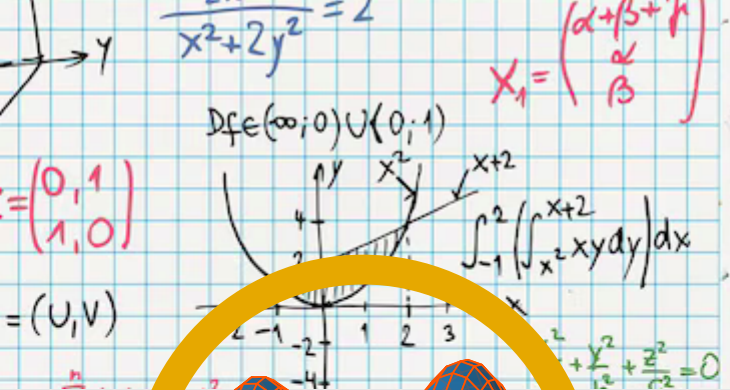

Bordj (Castle) El-Mokrani

Is one of the historical monuments contained in the wilaya of Bordj Bou Arreridj from which it takes its name, it is an important cultural heritage which testifies to several successive historical eras in the region. Dating from the Ottoman era, was built by Hassan Pasha, Ben Kheir-Eddine in 1525 on a rock with a height of 15 meters, the highest plateau in the region, used as an observation fort overlooking the entire city of Bordj Bou Arreridj.

In 1871 it was renamed in the name of the leader of the popular revolution Mohamed El Mokrani, when he wanted to take refuge against the successive attacks of the French army. In 1993, it was made available to the National Archeology Agency to return it to a museum.

In 2016, it was opened as a museum after being restored and rehabilitated.
